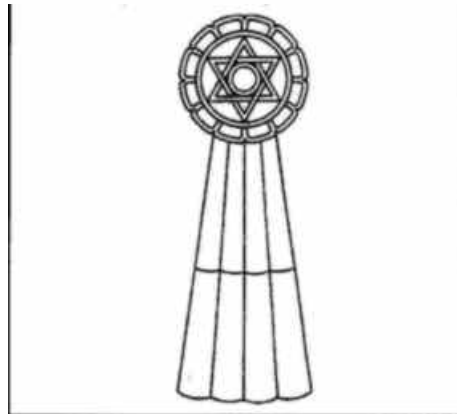

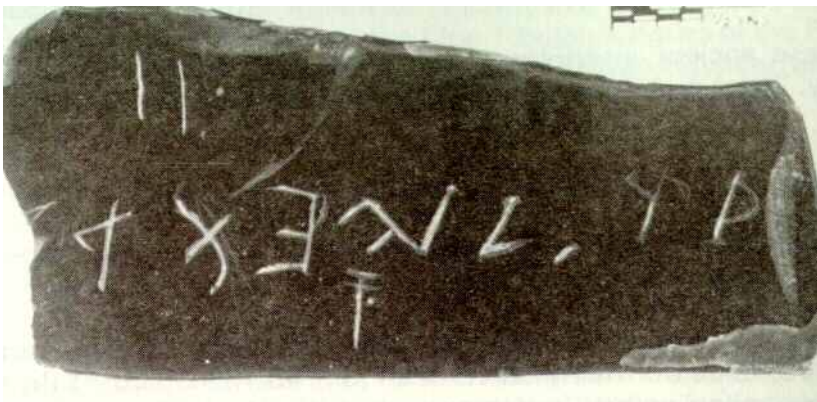
*Maya Star of David flower,

Guatemala City) .*



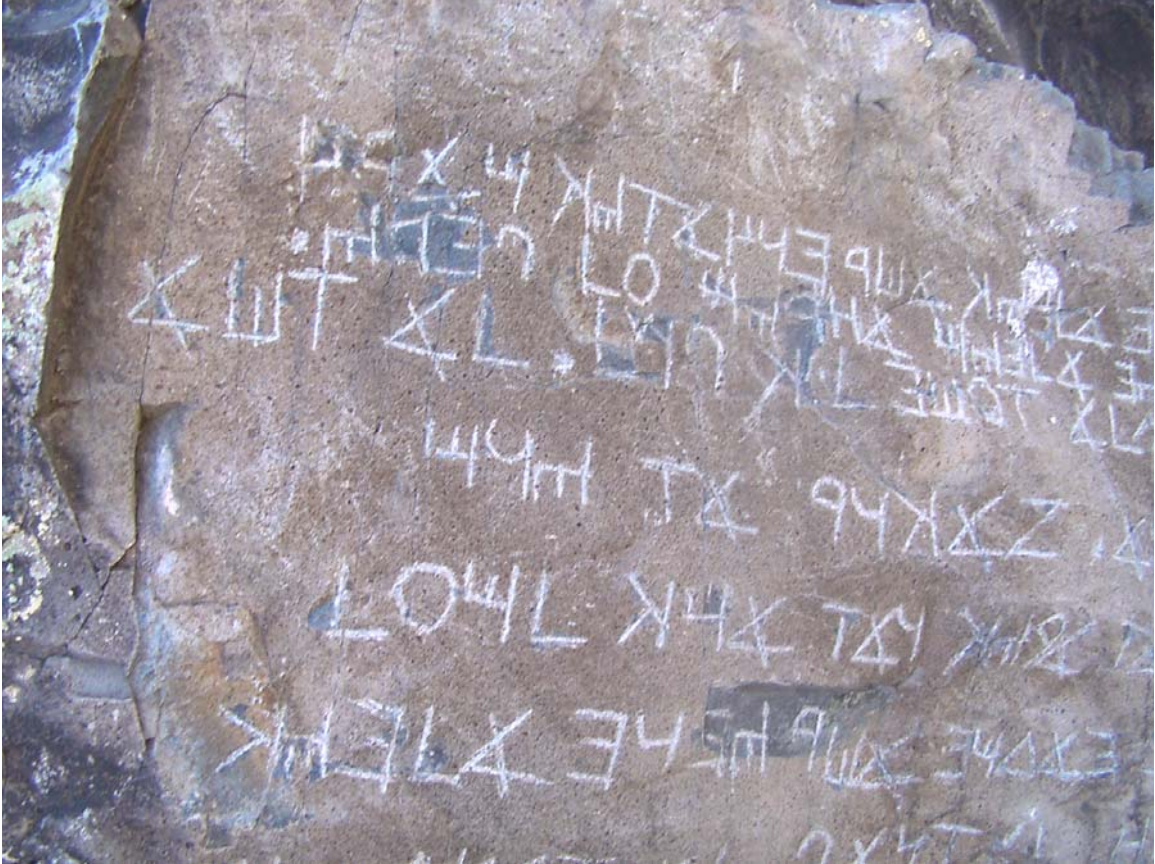
*Star of David with Pennated

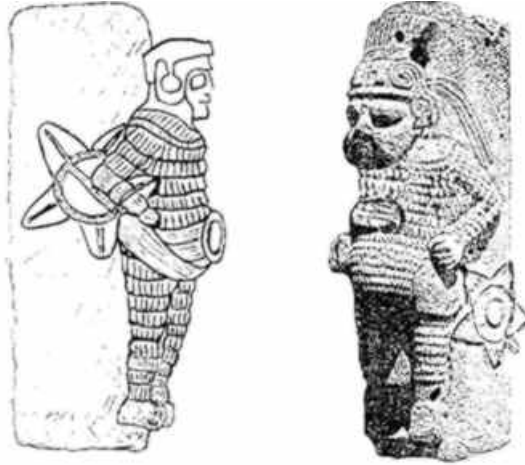
